Synoptic system:-

◆ The Low Pressure Area over northeast and adjoining areas of eastcentral Bay of Bengal, Bangladesh-Myanmar coasts with the associated cyclonic circulation extending upto 7.6 km above mean sea level persists. It is very likely to move northwestwards and become Well Marked Low Pressure Area during next 06 hours. Continuing to move northwestwards, it is likely to concentrate into a Depression by tomorrow morning, the 19th August over North Bay of Bengal and adjoining West Bengal & Bangladesh coasts. Thereafter, it is likely to move west-northwestwards across Gangetic West Bengal, North Odisha, Jharkhand and North Chhattisgarh and thereafter east Madhya Pradesh sub division and west Madhya Pradesh sub division.

Rainfall Activity during next 4 day's (starting from 19/08/2022)

19 /08/2022	Heavy rain in some part of Narmadapuram division and Adjoining Bhopal division	Heavy to very heavy rainfall in Rewa and Shahdol divisions.
20/ 08/ 2022	Heavy rain in part of Narmadapuum, Bhopal, Gwalior and Indore divisions	Very heavy to extremely heavy rainfall over Rewa, Jabalpur, Shahdol division and some parts of Sagar divisions
21/ 08/ 2022	Heavy to very heavy with isolated Extremely heavy rainfall in Narmapuram, Bhopal, Indore, Ujjain, Gwalior and Chambal divisions	Heavy to very heavy rainfall in Sagar and Jabalpur divisions
22/ 08/ 2022	Heavy to very heavy rainfall in Ujjain, Gwalior, Bhopal divisions	No warning
